



Fremantle lifesaver 'assessed' by peers

LARRY Tilbury was honoured at the Surf Life Saving WA's annual Awards of Excellence at The Esplanade Hotel in Fremantle.

The Fremantle Surf Life Saving Club member was named Assessor of the Year.

Since retiring as Fremantle Life Saver director, a position he held for six years, Mr Tilbury has devoted his time and efforts to improving the standard of lifesaving education, using his vast experience and knowledge, an awards spokesman said.

He has taken on a role with Surf Life Saving WA as a training consultant looking after five clubs in the organisation's Peel region – Fremantle, Coogee, Secret Harbour, Mandurah and Port Bouvard.

He has organised all assessments in the region and co-ordinated all but a handful of assessments in the region

this season.

As well as being recognised for improving lifesaving education, the surf club veteran always makes himself available to provide assistance or advice to other education officers, trainers and assessors, the spokesman said.
